Route Description

This route is an out and back from Walkerton to Urbanna on scenic county roads with light traffic. The terrain is relatively flat, although there are a few hills. The route crosses over several wooden bridges, which are quite bumpy. It is a good idea to slow down as you approach the bridges and proceed with caution over them. The cue sheet includes a lunch stop at Angelo's Colonial Pizza overlooking Urbanna Harbor. However, there are numerous other lunch options in and around Urbanna.
