## Route Description

This route is an out and back from the New Kent Winery on mostly county roads with light traffic. However, there is a stretch on Route 60 and a couple of stretches on New Kent Highway (Route 249). So, be extra careful! One highlight of this route is the area around Diascund Creek Reservoir, which is quiet scenic.

The Winery is cyclist friendly with very nice restroom facilities. However, they have a strict “no cleats” policy. Please change, or at least take off, your riding shoes before entering the Winery building.
